# GLOSSARY REVIEW

## COOPERATIVE EDUCATION:

A mode of delivering curriculum whereby students are provided with planned out-of school learning experiences which enhance in-school learning based on a particular Ministry of Education Curriculum Expectation

# IN-SCHOOL COMPONENT(S):

The school subject(s) based on one or more Ministry of Education Curriculum Expectation to which the out-of-school learning experience is related.

#### INTEGRATION SESSIONS:

The opportunity for students to share and analyze their out-of-school experiences with their peers in order to draw conclusions as to the relevancy of these experiences to their career goals.

#### MINISTRY OF EDUCATION CURRICULUM GUIDELINE:

A document governing the development of all in-school and out-of-school courses.

#### MONITORING:

Observation by a teacher or teachers knowledgeable in both the subject area and Cooperative Education of the student's behavior at the placement to evaluate the student's performance; done in consultation with both the student and the placement supervisor.

#### OUT-OF-SCHOOL COMPONENT:

The learning experience provided by the placement.

#### PRE-PLACEMENT ORIENTATION:

Classroom activities intended to provide information, and to develop skills and attitudes in order to facilitate the transition from school to the training station

#### SUPERVISOR:

A person responsible for the training and supervision, of a student at a placement.

# TEACHER-MONITOR:

The teacher responsible for planning and coordinating the student's out-ofschool program and for monitoring and evaluating the student's progress.

## PLACEMENT:

Any individual, business, government or community agency, which agrees to provide a training station and a supervisor for a Cooperative Education student.

#### PERSONALIZED PLACEMENT LEARNING PLAN:

A descriptive outline of the learning expectations for the out-of-school component of Cooperative Education programs.

#### TRAINING STATION:

The specific tasks or learning activities assigned to the student within a placement.

# WORK EDUCATION AGREEMENT:

A contract, whereby the student and placement agree to participate in a Work Education program.
