

CO-OP POSTER DISPLAY AND PRESENTATION

This is your opportunity to share your Co-op experience and your expertise in your field. This project is worth 20% OF YOUR FINAL MARK and is mandatory.

PART A: ASSEMBLE A JOB FAIR POSTER

Begin by producing a poster/display similar to a Science Fair Project. The poster should be approximately one meter tall and two meters wide. The Job Fair Poster is an overall summary of your Co-op placement that you will be presenting to the class. Remember to plan your format and to organize your information before assembling your poster/display. Allow time for pictures to be processed if you plan to include photographs or print the photos on your own printer.

Your poster/display must include the following:

- A) <u>POSTER TITLE</u>: Your title should indicate the business name, job title, supervisor(s) name(s) and the address.
- B) <u>TYPE OF BUSINESS</u>: Provide a brief description of the workplace and its business. (Approximately one page in length). Interview your supervisor and co-workers to obtain Information.
- C) JOB DESCRIPTION: Describe briefly the tasks and duties that you have performed during your Co-op placement. (point form can be used)

D) ESSENTIAL SKILLS & WORK HABITS:

- <u>E) MY CO-OP EXPERIENCE</u>: In this section discuss what you have learned and what you found to be most rewarding and interesting about your placement. As well you can include why you would recommend this co-op placement to another student.

- **G) SUBJECT LINK:** What is your linking subject and provide a specific example of how your work experience has been an extension of what you learned in that class. See your PPLP for reference.
- F) PHOTOGRAPHS, DRAWINGS, LITERATURE, PRODUCT SAMPLES: This could include samples of your work, or photographs showing the services or products of your employer, company brochures, website pages, business cards etc. (Note: All photographs should include captions.)
